The Newburgh enlarged City School District is in the process of developing district wide grade level content MAPS, shared interim assessments and instructional units aligned the New York State Next Generation Leering Standards for English Language Arts and mathematics, the K-12 Social Studies Framework and the P-12 Science Learning Standards. There is continued focus on our English as New Learner Students as their enrollment increases. Access to early learning opportunities in the district Universal Pre-Kindergarten and State Funded fall Day Pre-Kindergarten programs is supported through a locally budgeted share of the annual costs.

District-level administrators collaborate with school-based administrators, instructional coaches and lead teachers in department and grade level professional learning communities in each of the buildings. Professional development for teachers and other pedagogues is aligned with our locally-approved District Professional Development Plan. Targeted professional learning opportunities are responsive to community and professional annual surveys, student performance data and includes supports for our Students with Disabilities.
